Green Valley Enterprises started over 50 years ago when a small group of motivated parents wanted their adult children to be given the opportunity and choice to work. They presently serve over 400 families throughout the Dodge County area. In June of 2022, Opportunities, Inc. acquired Green Valley Enterprises to expand mission services in Dodge County for individuals; with the purpose of maximizing success and enhancing their abilities to be independent, contributing members of the community.



The two organizations combined their mission to expand service choices and social enterprises, while boldly advancing the lives of people with diverse abilities, backgrounds, and life circumstances. Coordinating efforts and expanding programs to build diversity and inclusion.

The goal of Green Valley Enterprises **Life Academy** is to build students' confidence related to living, learning, and earning within the community. Students learn communication skills, critical thinking, decision-making, problem solving, self-advocacy, resilience, & so much more.

GVE Life Academy offers community engagement and enrichment throughout the year, with a unique summer day program, transition service within the school year, as well as an after-school program. Community volunteering and employment opportunities provide a robust real-world learning environment for youth and young adults. Over 60 students from area communities and school programs throughout Dodge County received services annually.

Promoting self-determination.

In 2022, Opportunities, Inc. started the **Workplace Skills Apprenticeship** program; a great opportunity for the first-time employee or a young person starting out in the workforce. Participants in the program receive paid work exploration in a variety of entry level production jobs along with an emphasis on work readiness skills in preparation for a successful career path advancement.

Through the Opportunities, Inc. Workplace Skills Apprenticeship, Nick was given the opportunity to build his employment portfolio while learning work readiness skills in a real work environment, rather than a traditional classroom setting. Attitude, communication, teamwork, networking, and critical thinking, workplace respect, and performance expectations were some of the topics discussed. The apprenticeship guided Nick to be successful in his job at the Opportunities, Inc. Fulfillment Center.

While working in the Opportunities, Inc. Fulfillment Center, Nick was able to develop skills and experience towards his career path advancement. He found a job that brings him joy and purpose, enhancing confidence to become more outgoing, continuing to grow and find success. Opportunities, Inc. is committed to advancing the mission by cultivating hidden skills, developing confidence, personal responsibility and building a dynamic team. With a unique community focus, it is the goal of the Opportunities, Inc. Fulfillment & Training Center to advance a diverse workforce and expand mail order alternatives for an increasing customer base that engages in on-line ordering through large retailers and e-commerce sites.

The Opportunities, Inc. Fulfillment Center shipped nearly 125,000 orders and touched over 4.8 million items in 2022. The dedication and commitment of our diverse team made this

incredible feat possible. The **Workplace Skills Apprenticeship** provided six students with diverse abilities training and advancement of skills to prepare for the real world of work.


Along with record orders processed, installation of a new automated packaging line was completed, which will improve productivity and enhance training options. Dale, who has been a part of the team since graduating high school, was

Aligning expertise to expand services.



In July, the WorkSmart staff facilitated a Welding Cohort specifically for incarcerated individuals from the Burke Correctional Center in Dodge County to strengthen work skills post release.

In October, Opportunities, Inc. partnered with the Workforce Development Board of South-Central Wisconsin and Madison College to offer the first **Leadership Training Academy** for incumbent workers. Thirteen employees from five different companies participated in learning valuable tools to increase their leadership abilities and grow within their career paths. We, alongside Johnsonville Foods, Jones Dairy Farm, Aztalan Engineering, & Fisher Barton all supported this new initiative by selecting upcoming leaders to attend this training.


